Dyson Fraternity and Sorority Scholarship Award Program Facts

What is a Dyson Fraternity and Sorority Scholarship Award?

Established in 1998 through Cornell's Scholarship Challenge Campaign by John S. Dyson '65. Informally known as the "Dyson Scholarship Challenge" this award is intended for Greek undergraduates who demonstrate leadership qualities or hold a leadership position in their respective chapter.

Who is eligible for a Dyson Fraternity and Sorority Scholarship Award?

Students who qualify for grant and work-study through the Cornell Financial Aid Office and demonstrate a significant leadership role in their chapter are eligible. In the event a student meeting the financial-aid criteria cannot be identified in the group of nominees, another deserving member of the chapter who meets the necessary requirements may be selected to receive the scholarship. Seniors are not eligible.

How does it affect financial aid?

This award is a scholarship grant that relieves all or portions of the recipients' work-study requirements for the following academic year.

How to receive a Dyson Fraternity and Sorority Scholarship Award?

Students who meet the guidelines established by their respective chapter are nominated by their alumni corporation board to the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs and the Office of Financial Aid. Recipients are selected based on rank order established by the chapter and who have grant and self-help components in their financial aid package.

How to receive a Dyson Tradition Fellowship Fraternity and Sorority Scholarship Award?

Students who are in the University Tradition Fellowship Program and meet the guidelines established by their respective chapter are nominated by their alumni corporation board to the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs and the Office of Financial Aid.

How to apply for a Dyson Fraternity and Sorority Scholarship Award?

Students should submit a self-nomination form to the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Affairs by **April 1st**. Financial aid application materials must also be filled out and received by the Office of Financial Aid no later than **April 15th**.
